

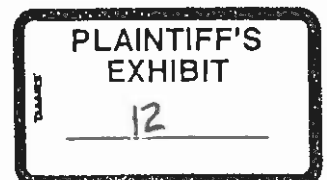
Hell stated he would like to make some changes. I concurred since the team Irving drafted is going no where. Anyway, to stop all the whining I caved in.

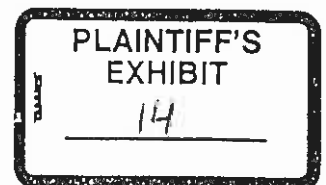
